The Amersham Pensioners' Association Website – Members Only Area


In order to be able to access the Members Only area of the TAPA website it is necessary to allow your browser to accept **cookies** from our website.

A **cookie** is a small piece of text, stored on a user's computer by a web browser and in the case of websites which require users to 'log-in' or access a protected area by means of a password, a cookie from the website will allow the server to know that the user is already authenticated, and is therefore allowed to access areas that are restricted to a user who is not logged in.


Some web browsers like *Mozilla Firefox* allows cookies for all websites on the standard installation and it is unlikely you will have any problems unless you have changed the default settings since installing, but *Internet Explorer* (which is part of the Windows installation) is initially set up to block them unless you tell it to allow them for specified websites. If you are using *Internet Explorer* to browse the internet, here's what you will need to do - it's not as difficult as it may seem and it will not leave your computer vulnerable to any security problems.

Launch *Internet Explorer* and go to <u>www.amershampensioners.com</u>.


Click on Tools and then Internet Options




Click on **Privacy**

Type **weebly.com** in the box labelled **Address of website.** Then click on **Allow.** Finally click on **OK**.
